

STREET MAINTENANCE WORKER

NATURE OF WORK

This is heavy manual labor involving semi-skilled work in various maintenance and construction tasks requiring the use of tools, equipment, and the operation of light automotive equipment within the Streets Division. Work is performed under the supervision of a crew leader or Streets Supervisor.

EXAMPLES OF DUTIES

Assists in the repair and cleaning of City streets, sidewalks, alleys, storm sewers, catch basins and City buildings; operates assigned equipment; performs other duties as assigned.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

Knowledge, Skills and Abilities

Some knowledge of tools and equipment used in general maintenance work; knowledge of occupational hazards and safety precautions applicable to laboring work; ability to learn the operation of light trucks, tractors and small automotive equipment; ability to understand and follow simple instructions; physical strength and ability to perform manual labor out of doors under extreme weather conditions.

Training and Experience

Graduation from a standard high school or GED; one (1) year experience in the use of general tools and equipment used in general maintenance work; background in construction maintenance.
