Item 4. Board member Updates. Mrs. Brust asked about the possibility of installing additional signage at the Rail Trail crossings to add another level of safety for both Trail users and motorists alike. In addition, there was discussion about the possibility of adding signage on the Rail Trail in Spring 2024, to remind pet owners of the potential for heat related injury to dog paws when being walked on the hot asphalt.

Mr. Freeman mentioned the Rail Trail was extremely dark after sunset with very little if any visible lighting in any direction. Discussed the need for lighting.

Mr. Freeman proposed the City explore the possibility of creating a Christmas-related visitor destination on the Walking Bridge next year. Just as Oaks by the Bay draws numerous visitors to walk the park to view and enjoy the various lighted decorations; the Walking Bridge could be transformed in much the same way with Christmas lights along the Bridge, plywood Christmas Cards, business sponsored Christmas Trees, etc..

Item 5. City Staff Updates. Mr. Farris gave an update on several grants the city is pursuing, including the possibility of a grant that would help fund solar lighting along the Rail Trail. He also gave an update on the plywood Christmas Card Project and the recent Florida Power & Light state-wide policy against mounting any type of decorations on their poles and how that may impact Lynn Haven with both Christmas decorations and various holiday banner displays in the future.

Mr. Ward gave an update about the various sports leagues as well as the upcoming Art in the Park on December 16, 2023.

Item 6. Discussion of the next meeting. The tentative date for the next Quarterly Board meeting was set for Wednesday, March 6, 2024.

There were no further comments, and the meeting was adjourned.
