### What's New in the City?

- The new City website has launched! The updated design will help you navigate faster & the overall look is more appealing.
- The Cain Griffin ball field's fencing now has yellow toppers to help make it a safer way for kids to play & enjoy.
- Rebuild plans are underway for the new City Hall/ Chambers, Police Dept., Fire Dept., Library, Public Works and the Sports Complex building and ballfields. Parts of Historic City Hall will be preserved!
- The old Library is set for demolition in late March 2021.
- Public Works is working on 11th St, removing blockage caused by tree roots growing through a joint in the 42" Stormwater outfall line that comes from Hwy 77. This should alleviate some of the flooding issues in this area.
- Public Works is working in Pine Forest Estates, putting in a new pipe to help drain some of the Stormwater discharge.
- The Hwy 77 Landscape Project is nearing completion (including additional newly planted Sylvester palms.)
