- Demolition to the old library and part of old City Hall started on March 22nd. The historical side of City Hall will remain.
- City Commission chose a winner for the City Entrance Sign Project. Mosley High School student, Nate Reeve's model was chosen.
- The Virginia Ave outfall ditch has been cleaned and widened as part of the Stormwater Master Plan. This should allow relief in areas as far away as 17th Street.

- New stormwater inlets were installed on 13th St. between Louisiana Ave and Arkansas Ave.
