What's New in the City?

- A live Oak has been planted at the Pocket Park at 9th and Illinois Ave.
- Mount Hope Cemetery received an updated historical marker sign. You can see it near the statue in the roundabout.
- The Bark Park at Kinsaul Park has new live Oak trees as well.
- Potholes at the end of 5th St near the Bark Park have been filled in.
- Within 30 days or so, the Lynn Haven Bayou Park & Preserve should be ready to open. The park still belongs to the state and is considered an active construction site, so please do not venture out as it is a felony trespass charge until open.
- Phase 1 of the Sports Complex has been approved by Commission & should begin construction within 45-60 days. This project includes 5 baseball fields, concession, batting cages, new sidewalks, lighting, etc. and should be completed by spring 2022.
