Utilities Update

The direct introduction of stormwater into the wastewater collection system causes sewer to back-up into homes, businesses and can create sewer overflows into waterways and other environmentally sensitive areas. Please help the City of Lynn Haven reduce sanitary sewer overflows by not plumbing your gutters into the sewer line of your home or business. Inspect and replace any damaged sewer clean-outs and caps. Homes and businesses with rain gutters and downspouts that discharge stormwater to the sewer service lateral, or a broken sewer clean-out is a violation of city ordinance 70-91 and 70-98 (12). Gutters and downspouts should drain onto your property or into the city's stormwater system, not the wastewater collection system. See examples on our website and Facebook page. Holiday Garbage Pick-Up



The office will be closed 12/24, 12/27, and 12/31. Garbage Service will run it's regular hours these days. PLEASE have your can(s) out to the curb no later than 6AM on your day of service. Make sure you are not overloading your cans or stacking items on top of your cans. Lids MUST completely shut or your can is overloaded. Don't cram boxes into your cans. When we pick them up we have to apply pressure to the cans (so they don't fall into the truck) If there is a box in that can, it becomes lodged and that box and everything beneath that box is not coming out. Take the time to break them down and place them beside you trash can on the ground.
