Permit to Discharge Stormwater Update

January 11, 2022

Background Information

- The permit is required by the Clean Water Act, 1972. City compliance started 1992.
- The City is currently in the fourth year of the fourth cycle (5 years per cycle) permit.
- No funding is provided by the State to administer the permit.
- Written report is required after the second and fourth years.
- Periodic inspection is conducted by the State.

Permit Elements

25 Permit elements in 6 categories:

- 1.) Public education and outreach.
- 2.) Public involvement and participation.
- 3.) Elicit discharge detection / elimination.
- 4.) Construction site stormwater runoff control.
- 5.) Post-construction stormwater management.
- 6.) Pollution prevention / good housekeeping.

- Tributary signage and drain markers
- Permit Review
- Update the City's stormwater website

Elicit Discharge Detection & Elimination

Maintain the City stormwater system map and provide update to commission bi-annually.

Maintain City Ordinance 26.32, litter control and illegal dumping.

Investigate illicit discharges pursuant to City Ordinance 26.32 and Article VII. -
STORMWATER SYSTEM

Promulgate illicit connection, dumping and discharge prevention information on the City website.

Inform public employees, businesses and the general public of associated hazards.

Construction Site Stormwater Runoff Control

Maintain City ordinance for relevant construction activity.

Monitor said construction activity.

Support appropriate construction control measures.

Implement construction site waste control measures pursuant to City ordinance 54.32.

Review proposed land development projects.

Maintain the City public “hot line”.

Continue building site inspection of control measures.

Post Construction Stormwater Management

- The City relies on current NFWFMD and FDEP regulatory criteria for City projects.

Pollution Prevention & Good Housekeeping

- Vehicle washing and fueling BMPs will be maintained and inspected monthly.
- Maintain the City's permitted stormwater management systems.
- Continue open space maintenance and pet waste bags.
- Conduct City employee training on stormwater pollution prevention and deduction.
